### ABOUT ROBERT COLLEGE

Robert College (RC) is a private, coeducational, day and residential secondary school located on a large urban-forest campus in the center of İstanbul, Türkiye. For 162 years, RC has served as a leader of educational excellence in Türkiye; notably, RC is the oldest continually running American school founded outside the USA.

### **ENROLLMENT**

Students are admitted to RC based solely on a highly competitive national exam; there are no legacy, sibling, or transfer student contingencies. Each year, RC typically admits students from within the top 0.01 - 0.3% of over one million test takers, making it the most academically selective private high school in Türkiye. Our residential program and need-based scholarships we are able to enroll a geographically and socioeconomically diverse student body.

### **ACADEMIC PROGRAM**

RC is accredited by both The New York State Association of Independent Schools (NYSAIS) and Türkiye's Ministry of Education (MEB). The school operates under the jurisdiction of MEB and awards a Turkish diploma (Lise Diploması).

Students pursue dual mastery of English and Turkish at university-level proficiency within a rigorous curriculum where they study Advanced Placement-level and further advanced courses in addition to the national high school curriculum.

### **GRADING**

Grading is unweighted and on a one hundred-point scale, with 60 as the passing mark. Although grades are multiplied by class hours to calculate each course's final grade, no courses, including APs, are given any extra weight. Given the nature of our enrollment, which brings in a cohort of high achieving and academically focused students, RC does not provide a grade-distribution table, nor do we report student's class rank.

### COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP)

CIP encourages students to develop community-focused critical thinking and action taking skills. Student-initiated and student-led, CIP projects fulfill needs in communities across the country. Students are required to complete at least 75 hours to graduate, yet we regularly see 40% or more exceed this minimum.



A note: students who are unable to take AP courses due to a schedule conflict or who wish to test in a subject not offered often study individually. On average, 99% of AP test takers score a 3 or above in at least one test.

### STUDENT LIFE

RC has over 130 co-curricular activities in areas ranging from orchestra to scuba diving, robotics to modern dance. There are over ten student publications including a newspaper established in 1959. Students regularly join international events like World Debate, World Scholar's Cup, and the United Nation Climate Conference. In Türkiye, RC is proud to have established the first student council (1892), opened the first medical school for women (1920), and hosted the first Turkish basketball game (1908).
